- 1) **Angry Orchard: Crisp Apple – Hard Cider, 5%**. It is the perfect balance of sweetness and bright acidity from culinary apples. \$3 for 16oz.
- 2) **Sierra Nevada: Hop Bullet, IPA, 8%**. With Hop Bullet, we're using a new technique, hitting the beer with a double-barreled blast of Magnum hops and lupulin dust—pure, concentrated hop flavor—directly into the tank to emphasize the intense pine and citrus flavors of classic West Coast hops.. \$4 for 16oz
- 3) **Sierra Nevada, Hazy Little Thing, Unfiltered, IPA, 6.7%**. BRAND NEW 2018 RELEASE!!! This was originally a brewery-only release, but it was so popular it got wide distribution. \$4 for 16oz
- 4) **Firestone: 805**. A light blonde ale for the chill lifestyle. \$4 for 16oz
- 5) **Brewer's Cabinet: Captain Jack's Belgian Golden – 5.5%** A Belgian style light beer, moderately hopped with Lemon Drop and Sorachi Ace hops, the yeast, malt and hops harmonize creating a light yet flavorful easy drinking beer, hints of tropical fruit and citrus. \$4 for 16oz
- 6) **Stone: VirtuALE – 7.7%** -- Escape into another world as you experience the intensity from this unique West-Coast IPA. Innovative engineering featuring a proprietary process paved the way for this collaboration—triggering big citrus notes of tropical fruit while 1-upping the dank, resin qualities of Citra & Mosaic.. \$5 for 16oz
- 7) **Modelo: Especial** – 4.4% -- Well-balanced taste and light hop character with a crisp, clean finish. Modelo Especial is characterized by an orange blossom honey aroma with a hint of herb. \$4 for 16oz
- 8) **Under the Rose: Paddy O'Stout Face – Irish Stout – 5%** -- ON NITRO, this locally made beer is Siri's darkest beer. Creamy and smooth served on nitro. \$4 for \$16oz
- 9) **Lagunitas: IPA – 6.2%** -- A well-rounded, highly drinkable IPA. A bit of Caramel Malt barley provides the richness that mellows out the twang of the hops.. \$4 for 16oz
- 10) **Brewer's Cabinet: Dragon Punch IPA** – Brewed locally in Reno, it's copper and ever-so-slight red hue, paired with a lemon forward, spiced hop character, truly sets it apart. \$4 for 16oz
- 11) **Brewer's Cabinet: Rain Shadow Milk Stout, 5.3%** Milk stout brewed with cocoa nibs. light roast flavor with hints of chocolate. This beer finishes slightly sweet because of the lactose, but very well balanced. \$4 for 16oz
- 12) **Brewer's Cabinet: Stranded Session IPA – 4.2%** - All the hops, with a little less booze to keep you going for a 2nd, 3rd, 4th round of beers. \$3 for 16oz
- 13) **Great Basin Brewing: 39 North Blonde Ale – 4.9%** - With a crisp malt flavor, a bright and refreshing finish, and just the perfect balance of hops, this brew was made to jump into – mouth first.. \$4 for 16oz
- 14) **Firestone Walker: Leo vs Ursus – WOOKUS.** – BLACK IPA – 8.2% - an imperial black rye IPA that is wickedly hoppy, righteously spicy and fearsome in flavor. \$5 for 16oz
- 15) **Sierra Nevada: Bigfoot 2018 – 9.6%** - Barleywine Style Ale - First introduced in the winter of 1983, Bigfoot is a cult-classic beer brewed in the barleywine style, meaning a strong, robust, bruiser of a beer with the refined intensity of a wine.. \$5 for 9oz
- 16) **Deschutes: Fresh Chair, 6.5%** - Northwest Pale AleA Red Chair NWP and Fresh Squeezed IPA collaboration brew with Larry Sidor and Cam O'Connor at Crux Fermentation Project, both former brewers at Deschutes Brewery \$4 for 9oz
- 17) **BONUS BEER!!! Now available -- \$3 for a 16oz can– SAM ADAMS NEW ENGLAND IPA – 6.8% - With a juicy, luscious mouthfeel and opaque, hazy appearance, this beer is best enjoyed fresh.**

NEW ENGLAND IPA

Born inside our nano brewery in Boston, Samuel Adams New England IPA is a medium-bodied, hazy brew featuring a big punch of citrus juiciness.

The slight sweetness is perfectly balanced by the pineapple and grapefruit hop character, without being overly bitter. Clocking in at 6.8% ABV and a low 35 IBUs, the unfiltered IPA provides a burst of fruited hop aroma and leaves drinkers wanting another sip. In comparison to West Coast style IPAs which have prominent hop bitterness and a light, dry mouthfeel, New England IPA's are generally known for a juicy, luscious mouthfeel and opaque, hazy appearance - and are best enjoyed fresh.
